



Stakeholder Consultation for Bulk Drugs Park, Bhatinda

Context

With the aim to promote self-reliance in manufacturing of bulk drugs by reducing manufacturing cost and increasing competitiveness of domestic bulk drugs industry through easy access to standard testing & infrastructure facilities, Government of India has notified a scheme called "Promotion of Bulk Drugs Parks". The guidelines were notified on 27 July 2020.

Given the budding pharmaceutical sector in the State of Punjab, Government of Punjab is desirous of developing a bulk drugs park at Bhatinda (Land area 1300 acres) for attracting investments in Pharmaceuticals segment.

Thus, to understand the requirements of the pharma units in Punjab, to take industry feedback on the State Government's bulk drugs park proposal and generate interest from key players, Punjab Government will be organizing an industry stakeholder consultation.
