**Subject: Extension of time limit for submission of claims related to expenditure incurred on statutory compliances abroad – reg.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to the mail dated 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 from the Director General, Pharmexcil on the above mentioned subject and to state that in view of the unprecedented situation caused by COVID-19, it has been decided, with the approval of the competent authority, to extend the time limit prescribed at Sl. No.11 of the Table, below para 6.1 of the Guidelines for Funding under the MAI Scheme, related to submission of claims by the exporters in respect of reimbursement of expenditure incurred on statutory compliances abroad, to the concerned EPC/ FIEO, from 90 days to 180 days, for the claims pertaining to the financial years 2019-20 and 2020-21.
