Immunization Strategy campaign (launched December 2020)

Priority in Population Immunization

 Objective(s) Immunize 80% of the country's population to achieve herd immunity and thus flatten the curve of COVID-19 infections.


Quick start of immunization

• Chile was one of the first countries in LATAM to start vaccinating its population against COVID-19 which has been free and voluntary.

Speedy vaccination process

• Being one of the fastest vaccinations in the world. In a few weeks, by mid-March, it had managed to vaccinate a quarter of its population achieving the desired herd immunity August 2021

Essential elements of the planning and development design of the COVID-19 vaccination campaign in Chile.




Achievements


early diversification of commercial agreements and scientific collaboration with developers of COVID-19 vaccines

By August 9, 2021, the country managed to vaccinate **80% of its population**

in August 2021, third booster doses

in May 2022, fourth booster doses





Conclusions

- Evidence shows that vaccination alone will not eliminate SARS-CoV-2, as population prevention and self-care measures still need to be maintained.
- The vaccination campaign has allowed Chile to move towards an initial opening, ending quarantines
- Promoting international cooperation on immunization and the exchange of good practices and experiences is essential to address the current and future challenges of COVID-19
