Subject: Implementation of the enhanced financial assistance under the MAI Scheme for reimbursement of product registration charges etc. incurred by exporters abroad- reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to EP(Pharma) Division's OM No. K-55011(14)/2017-EP(Pharma) dated 19th July, 2019 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the revision in the MAI Scheme, intimated vide this Division's letter of even number dated 7th January, 2019, has been made effective from the date of issuance of the order i.e. 7th January, 2019. In this regard, it is clarified that only one - fourth of the enhanced assistance, i.e. Rs.37.50 lakhs, over and above the earlier ceiling of Rs.50 lakhs, per exporter per annum will be available for reimbursement for the financial year 2018-19. Further, the enhanced assistance will be admissible for only such certificates, for which application was made to the concerned regulatory authority, etc. on or after 7th January, 2019.
